

Cold War Era Extra Credit Assignment

Unit 10.6 of the New York State Regents Curriculum covers the *Unresolved Global Conflict (1945 to 1991 – The Cold War)*. For this extra-credit assignment you must follow the instructions below.

1. Choose **one (1) major event** that took place during the Cold War and write a two-paragraph summary of the location, ideological or political or economic or military occurrences that took place. In addition to the two-paragraphs you are to add an image that validates your summary. It can be something such as a map, a photo, a chart, or a graph.

2. During the above time-frame, many countries that were once under imperialistic rule by Western powers fought for their independence. Choose **one (1) country** that fought for and achieved their independence during this time period. **You can NOT use Israel** for your country. Write a two-paragraph summary about the events that took place, including the key people involved in their attempts for independence and explain why this country was successful in gaining their freedom from their imperial rulers. In addition you are to add an image that validates your summary. It can be something such as a map, a photograph, or a similar image.

Each section is worth 5 points, for a total of 10 points that upon grading, will be added to the score of your last test.

Any Assignments received after this time will **NOT** be accepted for extra credit.

Make sure that your name is clearly indicated on the assignment.
