Year	People Granted the Vote
Late 1700's	Most White Men aged 21 or older who meet Property Requirements of State Laws
Early 1800's to 1850's	Most White Men aged 21 or older (State Laws)
1870	African American Men (15 th Amendment)
1920	All Women (19 th Amendment)
1961	People in the District of Columbia in presidential elections (23 rd Amendment)
1971	People aged 18 or older (26 th Amendment)
