

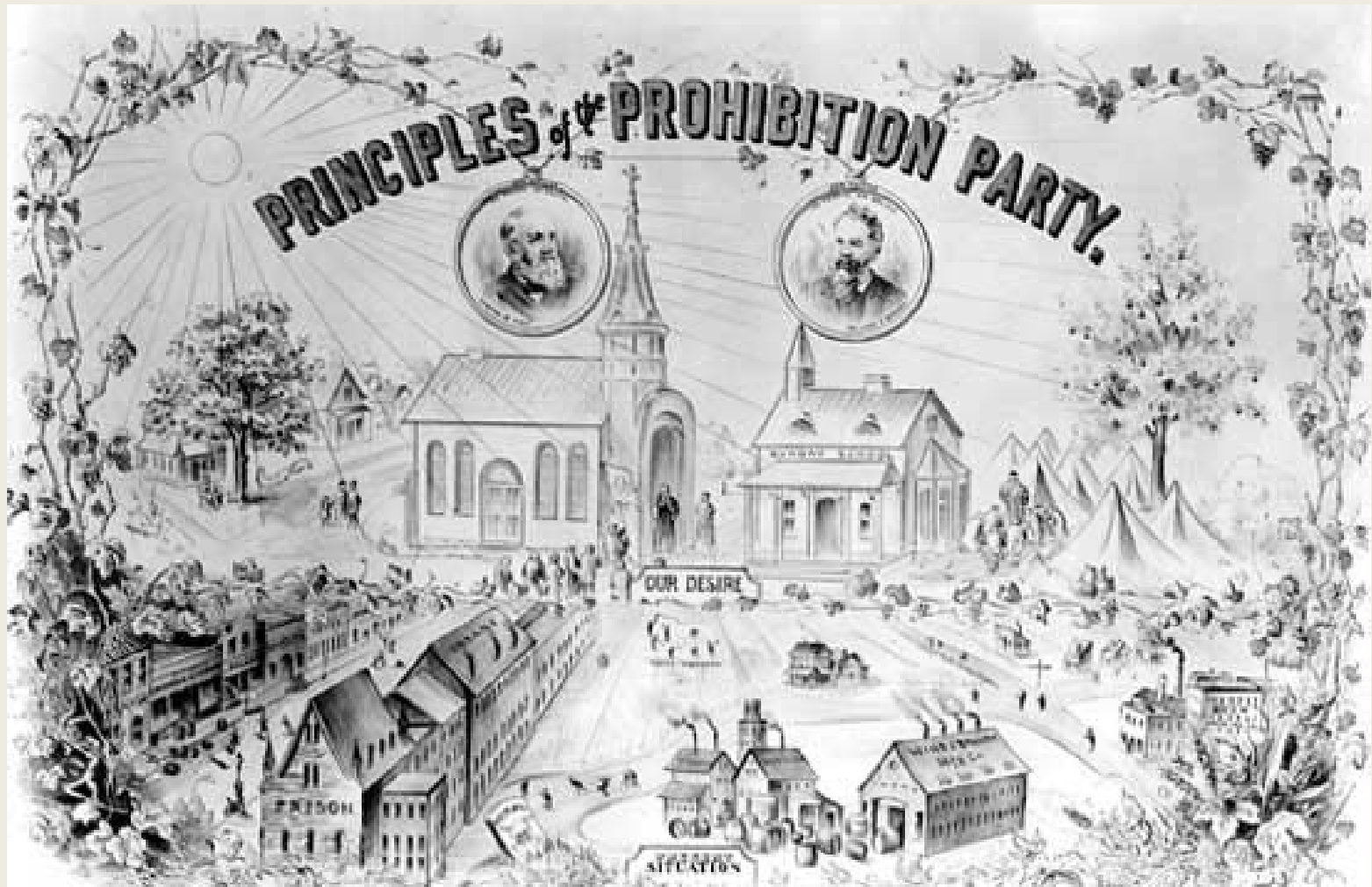

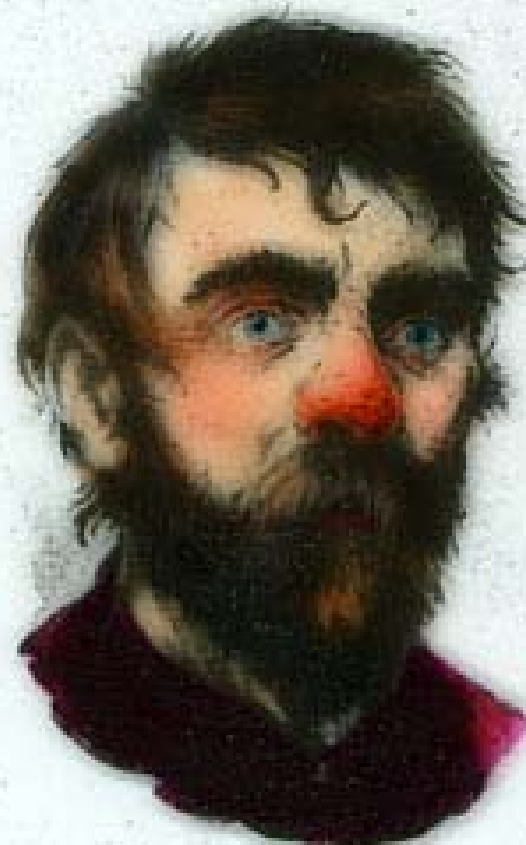


The Ladies of Logan sing hymns in front of a local saloon
